NEW GRASS SEED – Several grassy areas that were damaged by snow plows and a few spots where trees were removed were seeded last week. ROCKS IN GRASS Please remove any rocks that may have landed in your lawn to avoid any window damage now that we're into lawn mowing season. Also, be sure your downspouts have adequate extensions to drain the water away from your foundation.

Recycling Tips from Waste Management

- ✚ Plastic bags may not be placed in the Waste Management recycling bin. Either place them in the trash or place them in a plastic bag recycling bin at the grocery store.
- ✚ Styrofoam may not be placed in the Waste Management recycling bins. This includes Styrofoam cups, takeout food containers and packing material, which go in the trash.
- ✚ Shredded paper is not recyclable. Place it in a bag and put it in the trash bin.
